

Getting around

Ebernoe Common is located three miles north of Petworth. Car parking is available off Streele's Lane which runs between the A283 and Ebernoe hamlet. The car park is by the church and is accessed by a track near a phone box.

Ancient woodland accounts for about half of this 156 hectare reserve — a Site of Special Scientific Interest, Special Area of Conservation, and a National Nature Reserve. It is easy to get lost in the complex system of paths and rides, but the best starting place is from the car park next to the church off Streele's Lane — that way just heading north should bring you back! The ground is flat, but can be muddy, and there are one or two stiles in the boundary fences. The areas to the east and south are farmland under conversion to pasture woodland, with many footpaths providing pleasant walks throughout, best accessed from the Balls Cross-Northchapel road.
