This programme takes an in-depth look at how living things work. An investigation into populations of pond and stream creatures will be carried out where pupils can look closely at their adaptations using the interactive microscopes and whiteboard.

Pupils will also investigate the woodland environment, recording data on light and temperature levels using LogIT equipment.

The main emphasis of the day is on hands-on practical activity and games. We will also be recording information and evaluating results of our investigations, and you will be able to take the data back to school for further analysis and investigation.
